

SAY NO!



Kent Recycling and Land Reclamation, LLC has proposed to the Kent County Commissioners to create a “Construction Debris Rubblefill” in the headwaters of the Sassafras River.

- **“Kent” Recycling isn’t ‘From Here’ or ‘Come Here’ – it’s a corporation that wants to “Dump Here.”**
- **The operation will bring 6 to 10 truckloads per hour of construction debris from Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware into Kent County.**
- **This project is located at the head of Jacob’s Creek, a highly sensitive headwaters stream of the impaired Sassafras River.**
- **Already the Sassafras River is heavily polluted and cannot absorb any more contamination.**
- **Increased sediment and pollution loads from this project will dramatically impact the Sassafras River and nearby creeks, and the facility will cause increased noise, traffic, and air pollution.**
- **Toxic contaminants will be dumped at the facility and pose a threat to local drinking water supplies, in an area where everyone relies on well water.**
- **Liners in dumps such as this one are known to fail, resulting in permanent contamination of groundwater, soils, surrounding household wells, and adjacent waterways.**
- **The dump will result in 75-foot tall mountains of debris, hundreds of yards long, visible along US 301 – just inside Kent County.**
